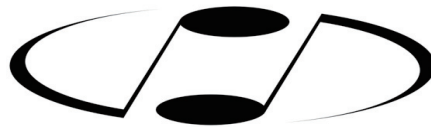

Dear Student Friends,

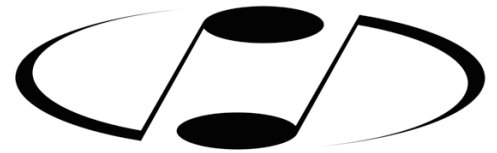
The WFMT Assembly of Student Delegates (ASD) is proud to be hosting the second triennial Student Poster Session during the 15th World Congress of Music Therapy.

Submission Guidelines

1. CONTENT

- Prepare a one-page poster highlighting your *music therapy* student organization or individual special projects.
 - **Examples:** Organizational purpose, goals, projects, and achievements;
Student service trips;
Early clinical reports and research...
 - **Sample poster:** ASD Poster (2014) - http://www.wfmt.info/wp-content/uploads/2014/09/WCMT-Student-Poster-2014_University-of-Windsor_FINAL.pdf
- Posters must be submitted in English. The WFMT Executive Assistant will review all posters for language support and make recommendations for revisions, if necessary.

2. FORMAT

- Final posters should be submitted in high-quality PDF format. Please retain a version that can be easily edited in case revisions are suggested.
 - Pictures included on posters should be high-resolution (no lower than 150dpi).
- Dimensions for printed posters should be no larger than 610mm (width) x 914 mm (height), or A1 paper size.
 - You are responsible for arranging printing services for your poster.
 - It is recommended that you place the poster inside a sturdy cardboard canister, or similar item, for protection while traveling.

3. TIMELINE [all deadlines are 5pm (UTC-5)]

- **November 30, 2016:** Notify WFMT Executive Assistant (assistant@wfmt.info) of intention to participate. Include:
 - Student organization or individual name,
 - Contact person (*if a student organization*),
 - Title of poster, and
 - Brief description of content
- **January 31, 2017:** Submit PDF of poster to WFMT Executive Assistant via email (assistant@wfmt.info). Ms. Brault will confirm receipt of submissions via email.
- **March 15, 2017:** Submit requested revisions, if any, to WFMT Executive Assistant
- **October 5, 2016 - May 31, 2017:** Register to attend 15th World Congress of Music Therapy
- **July 2017:** Present poster at Student Poster Session during the 15th World Congress of Music Therapy; Tsukuba, Japan
